**Reasons we need Rust Street and Kids Eat**

- 10 of the poorest US counties are in Texas
- Poverty rate in Texas is 25% higher than the nation as a whole
- Texas is the third highest food insecure state with a rate of 14.8% in the nation
- Texas has the fifth highest poverty rate amount children
- 60.2 % of the households that receive help from the food bank make less than a \$1,000 per month
- 16.5% of Texans live in poverty
- Texans receiving food stamps receive an average of \$93 per month
- \$20,650 per year is the poverty line for a family of 4 in 2007
- 1.3 million Texans are food insecure
- 1.3 pounds of food is needed to feed one person per meal
- The Texas Food Bank Network provided 214 million lbs. of food in 2008
