1. Use the Ten Commandments in your prayer time this week. Let these commandments guide your self-examination and your requests for others before God.
2. Paul encourages the Philippians, "Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others" (Phil. 2.4). This week make self-denial a reality and not merely a good intention. Deliberately place the needs and interests of those around you ahead of your own.
3. Meditate on the image Paul uses for the new life in Christ: resurrection with Christ. As you reflect, keep these words in mind: "Do I believe that Christ was raised from the dead? How can I believe the same of myself?"
