What to do before and after November 13th

1. Pick up your food box in the foyer, write a prayer on the prayer card and drop it in the box.
2. Go to the store and select the items on the food list. If you have children take them with you so they can experience the spirit of giving.
3. During the days to come look up the scriptures on the handout and share these with your family. Pray over the food several times before it is delivered as well as the family who will receive the food.
4. If you know of a family that is hurting give their names and addresses to Rust Street and we will take it from there.
5. Bring your food box to the parking lot November 13 and we will take it to the gym for you. The box will be checked and items added. If your box is ready before the 13th drop off your box in the church office.
6. Please do not interlock the flaps on the food box—tape the bottom of the box **only**.
7. Decide how many boxes you would like to deliver and pickup your name & addresses at the designated tables.
8. Drive down the back alley of the church building and pray with an elder who will waiting for you. Then take the boxes of blessings to your families. Come back to the Family Center & join us for lunch.
9. Go back to the houses of your choice during the holidays and see what else we need to do for them.
10. Invite the family or adults out to eat and develop a relationship with them.
11. Invite them to church services - you will make a difference once they realize how much you care about Jesus and them!
