3. Think of those who serve you on a regular basis (spouse, teachers, friends, etc.). Find a new way to express your appreciation to one of these people this week.

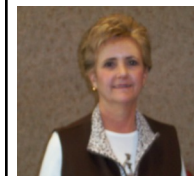

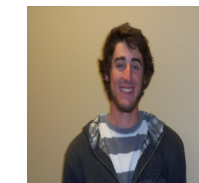
BUDGET SUNDAY

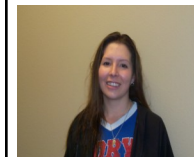

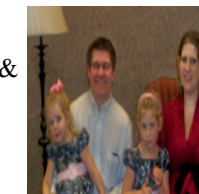

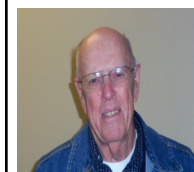
