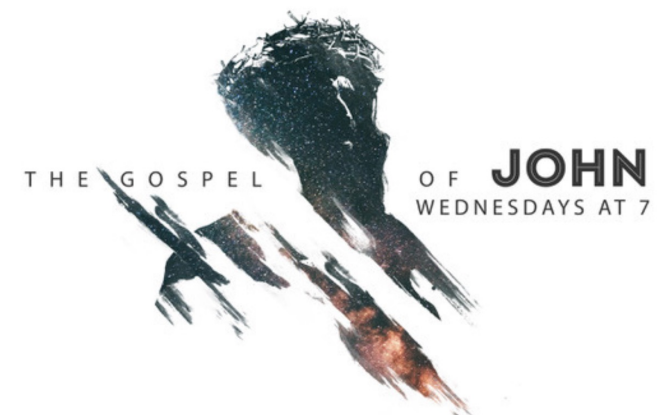
-Fully staffed nursery available for our infants and children up to 4 years of age.

Join Scott Allen in room 215 for a deep dive into the text of the gospel of John.

"BEMA" is a Hebrew word that refers to the elevated platform in the center of first-century synagogues where the people of God read the Text. At that time, the community of God's people did not gather in buildings that faced a stage with an audience, but rather they allowed their gathering to reflect what they hoped to be true of their lives – it was centered around the Word of God.



The BEMA Podcast is walk-through of the context of the Bible and the Text itself, as well as surrounding history. It is our desire to create a space to learn and grow, experiment and fail. A space where asking questions is incentivized and not discouraged. A space that God could fill — the way He desires to fill it.

To love God.

To love others.

To become people of the Text.

We will deconstruct our common readings of the Bible and attempt to reconstruct them through the lens of historical context. We will be pursuing Scripture through the lens of a historical, Jewish perspective to gain context, ask better questions, trust the Story, engage with the Content, learn how (not WHAT) to think, and become a person of the text.

This introduction of the BEMA podcast and discussion group will meet on Wednesday evenings at 7 pm sharp September 6 through November 15. We will meet upstairs in room 221. Each participant will listen to the week's podcast on their own or with their family, and meet to discuss.
