Rust Street Ministries exists to support our neighbors who are in need of temporary assistance. We exist to contribute to the spiritual, emotional, and physical needs of people in the Concho Valley. We partner with dozens of local churches and agencies, and countless individuals and businesses in the San Angelo area. In 2021 we assisted 11,057 people 119,036 lbs. of food, 32,775 articles of clothing, 6,912 household items, 554 pieces of furniture, 84 youth beds, 301 appliances, and 86 bicycles.
