As many of you know, the Texas Constitutional Carry Law goes into effect on September 1st. This means anyone who is legally able to possess a handgun may carry without a license or training. The Elders have decided to keep our current firearm policy in effect which is to NOT allow "Open Carry" at our services but allow concealed carry only if you are licensed to do so. Please remember that every Sunday, we have a Police Officer, multiple armed members of our trained security team and medical personnel on duty. Therefore, we ask that in the event of an emergency you allow these people to do their job. If a situation developed, we would have difficulty determining who might be a problem if weapons were drawn by unauthorized individuals.
