If you would like to register your home to pass out candy to Johnson Street kids, please do so by clicking on the "House" form and filling out all the information. All of your info will be kept private, except for your home address. We will create a private list of home addresses to give to JSK parents and guardians who sign their kids up to Trick-or-Treat. If you are in need of some extra candy, we will be taking donations of candy from other church members leading up to this event. You can indicate if you need candy on the registration form, and we will help get some of the donated candy to you.

If you would like for your child to participate in this fun evening of trick-or-treating, please fill out the "Parent/Guardian" form and provide us with all of the necessary information. This will give us a head count on how many kids to prepare for. It also allows us a safe and secure way to send you the house list for trick or treating.
