

On February 10th of this year, Phyllis and Antenor Goncalves celebrate 23 years of service in Itu. When they arrived in Itu, they joined Allen and Maria Dutton to see a small church of 25 people multiply, and become a vibrant, active, visionary, mission-minded church in the region of Itu. Itu has been instrumental in planting several churches in the region, and sending out mission teams of their members to do short-term missions in several Brazilian states. In October 2018, a team of 16 members traveled to Marromeu and Nensa districts in Mozambique to serve churches and the community.

The local ministries of the Itu church include: Crescimento Limpo led by Mark and Ali Kaiser. They have reached out to the homeless and drug and alcohol addicts through this ministry and blessed dozens of people spiritually, as well as giving them job skills, life skills, and dignity to live an independent life.

Another local ministry is CURA (Cuidado, Respeito e Amor) – Care, Respect, and Love – started out as an annual medical campaign 11 years ago with the leadership of Dr. Greg Dunham from JSCC. Greg and his medical team from the U.S. join hands with Brazilian medical volunteers, and together they provide services for hundreds of people during the week of CURA in July. CURA has grown through the years, and includes a tutoring program, community projects, and other projects as needs arise.

Other ministries include CampRoots, a bilingual camp in which members at JSCC have participated and led. Multiplica, our multimedia ministry, is a spinoff of the radio and TV ministry Antenor has led for 23 years. Semeadores is an annual weekend leadership conference.
