Whether you are new or have been coming for a while, we want to help you get connected. Drop by the CONNECTION CENTER located between the front doors in the lobby, or you can find and fill out the Check-in form online using the QR code on the back of the pews.

QUIET SPACES FOR OUR LITTLEST ONES

There is a Nursing Mothers' Room available to the mothers of young children in the congregation, located out the left front side doors of the auditorium. There is now a Sitting/Soothing Room where others can go to rock a child that needs a quiet space. This is in the former Parlor (past the women's restrooms off the lobby on the way to the Nursery). We would like to kindly remind everyone that the designated nursing mothers' area is a private space intended for breastfeeding or pumping. We ask that you refrain from entering or using the area unless you are a nursing parent. Thank you for helping us support a respectful and comfortable environment.

WE LOVE OUR KIDS!

We have a fully **staffed nursery** for infants and toddlers up to 4 years of age available every Sunday during both class time and worship, as well as on Wednesday evenings. The nursery is located down the hall from our lobby.

Bible classes for kids in PreK (age 4/5) through 12^{th} grade are offered Sunday mornings at 9:00AM, and Wednesday evenings at 7:00PM.

JSK (age $4-5^{th}$ grade) are in the children's wing,

JSY (6^{th} – 12^{th} grades) meet in the youth room by the gym.

ONE WAY is a time for kids that are 4 years old thru 4th grade to learn more about God through videos and engaging activities offered during the sermon on Sundays. **ONE WAY does not meet in the months of June or December.**


