## SPACES FOR OUR LITTLE ONES

You'll find a fully **staffed nursery** for infants and toddlers up to 4 years of age available every Sunday during both class time and worship, as well as during Wednesday evenings class. The nursery is located down the hall from the lobby, and one of our attendants at the Connection Center will gladly show you the way there.

There is a **Nursing Mothers' Room** available to the mothers of young children in the congregation located out the left front side doors of the auditorium. *We would like to kindly remind everyone that the designated nursing mothers' area is a private space intended for breastfeeding or pumping. Thank you for helping us support a respectful and comfortable environment.*

There is also a **Sitting/Soothing Room** where others can take a child that needs a quiet space. This is in the former Parlor (past the women's restrooms off the lobby on the way to the Nursery).

**Buddy Bags** are available on the left credenza in the lobby. Buddy Bags were created to accommodate those with sensory sensitivities and/or active bodies and hands to use during Sunday morning worship while in the building. Noise reducing headphones are available to check out at the Connections Center. **Please return All headphones, Buddy Bags, and contents to the return basket at the end of service.**
