QUIET SPACES FOR OUR LITTLEST ONES

There is a Nursing Mothers' Room available to the mothers of young children in the congregation, located out the left front side doors of the auditorium. There is now a Sitting/Soothing Room where others can go to rock a child that needs a quiet space. This is in the former Parlor (past the women's restrooms off the lobby on the way to the Nursery). *We would like to kindly remind everyone that the designated nursing mothers' area is a private space intended for breastfeeding or pumping. Thank you for helping us support a respectful and comfortable environment.*

WE LOVE OUR KIDS!

We have a fully **staffed nursery** for infants and toddlers up to 4 years of age available every Sunday during both class time and worship, as well as on Wednesday evenings. The nursery is located down the hall from our lobby.

Bible classes for kids in PreK (age 4/5) through 12th grade are offered Sunday mornings at 9:00AM, and Wednesday evenings at 7:00PM.

JSK (age 4 – 4th grade) are in the children's wing.

The Bridge (5th & 6th grades) meet in the Bridge Room upstairs (room 208).

JSY (7th – 12th grades) meet in the youth room by the gym.

ONE WAY is a time for kids that are 4 years old thru 4th grade to learn more about God through videos and engaging activities offered during the sermon on Sundays. ****ONE WAY does not meet in the months of June or December.****

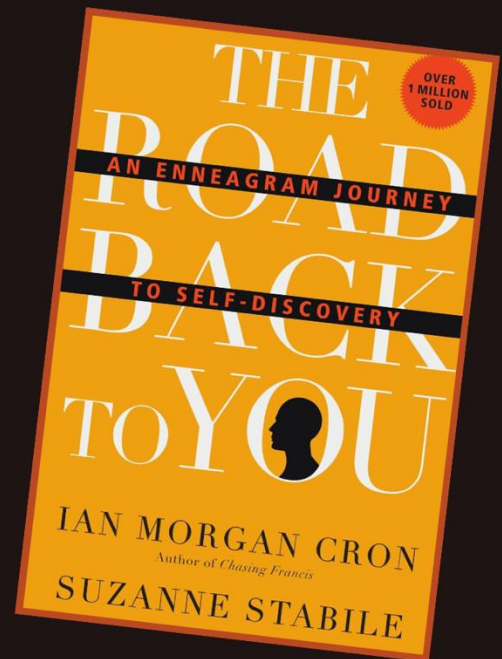

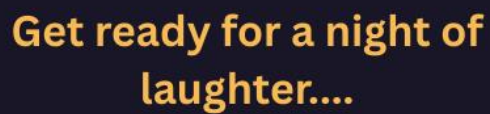
Operations Manager
